<p><b><u>TOPS</u></b>★</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students have the option to wear SVA spirit wear on these days, <u>otherwise they must wear an official SVA polo or oxford shirt as outlined under Tuesday-Thursday</u> (see POLO/OXFORD →)</li> </ul> <p><b><u>SPIRIT WEAR</u></b>★</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This includes polos, oxfords, t-shirts, hoodies, sweatshirts and jackets with the new official SVA logo and/or clothing affiliated with other official SVA clubs, organizations or classes. <i>Former SVA logo is not permitted.</i></li> </ul> <p>★These are purchased through SVA's Home &amp; School Association.</p> <p><b><u>BOTTOMS</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All students (1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade) must wear pants, shorts, or skirts in a variety of solid colors, with a zipper and/or button. E5/K students may wear solid colored bottoms with elastic bands. All bottoms must adhere to modesty guide lines (see below↓).</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>POLO</u></b>★</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All students (E5/K-12<sup>th</sup> Grade) are to wear an official SVA polo. This may be a short or long sleeved sport polo shirt with three buttons and a turnover collar in blue or gray with the official new SVA logo.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>OXFORD</u></b>★</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Short or long-sleeved button up shirt with a turnover collar which is offered in white and light blue.</li> </ul> <p>★These are purchased through SVA's Home &amp; School Association.</p> <p><b><u>BOTTOMS</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All students (1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade) must wear pants, shorts, or skirts in a variety of solid colors, with a zipper and/or button. E5/K students may wear solid colored bottoms with elastic bands. All bottoms must adhere to modesty guide lines (see below↓).</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>SHOES</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Footwear must be worn at all times.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>HEAD WEAR</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Caps, hats, bandannas, and/or sweat bands are not allowed</li> </ul> <p><b><u>JEWELRY</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No jewelry (other than medical bracelets) is to be worn at school, or while participating in any school function (on or off campus). <i>This includes earrings, nose rings/pierced studs, rings, bracelets, necklaces, and/or chokers, etc.</i></li> </ul> <p><b><u>TATTOOS</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No visible tattoos</li> </ul> <p><b><u>HAIRSTYLES</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Clean, well-groomed</li> <li>No radical hairstyles</li> <li>Only natural color hair dye</li> </ul> <p><b><u>P.E. UNIFORM</u></b> (On days designated)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>P.E. uniform and gym shoes are to be worn during gym, weight class, &amp; gymnastics for Grades 6-12</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>MODESTY GUIDELINES</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Refrain from spandex, leggings/jeggings, pants with ripped/holes/frayed, shorter than mid-thigh, sagging/bagging, or sweatpants/jogging/athletic wear.</li> <li>Sheer, tight-fitting clothing is not allowed.</li> <li>Girls Bathing Suit must be a modest one piece, tankini where the shirt meets the bottoms, no string bottoms, or a bikini with a t-shirt over top (that is not white) which stays on the entire time</li> </ul>
