HOW TO APPLY:

- _____ Complete the SVA Financial Assistance Request Form and return via email or drop off at the SVA front office.
- _____ Complete a FACTS Grant & Aid Application at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3XL55>.
Note the following:
 - Only on-line applications will be accepted
 - FACTS Grant & Aid charges a \$30 processing fee
 - You must submit your 2017 tax return (all pages) and all your 2017 W-2's

 - Completion of the FACTS application does not guarantee an award.

BOTH the SVA Financial Assistance Request Form and FACTS Grant & Aid Application MUST BE COMPLETED in order to be considered for Financial Assistance. You will be notified on or before August 1 of the results of your application.
