

**Dress Code & Uniform Policy** Effective Jan. 3, 2022

## **TOPS/ SHIRTS:**

## Monday - Thursday:

E5/K-12<sup>th</sup> grade students will wear a **Spring Valley Academy** logo \*uniform polo purchased online through SVA's vendor, **Lands' End School.** Note that a polo must be worn under all outerwear on these days. \***Parents should contact an SVA vice principal for direction concerning delayed polo orders.** 

#### Friday:

E5/K-12<sup>th</sup> grade students have the option to wear a SVA sponsored club, extra-curricular, or other school program *t*-shirt. Students may also wear an SVA logo Lands' End polo as they do on Monday-Thursday.

Layers allowed in colder months: long sleeved shirts in the following <u>solid</u> colors may be worn under short sleeved SVA shirts; white, navy blue, gray, black, yellow, or royal/cobalt blue. No prints or stripes are allowed.

### **OUTERWEAR:** All items should be marked with the student's name

# Monday - Thursday:

**Colors:** Outerwear worn in the building must be one of these solid colors <u>heather/light gray</u> or <u>royal/cobalt blue</u> **Apparel allowed:** \* Zip-front jackets, zip-front sweatshirts, button or zip-front sweaters, and crew neck (without a hood) sweatshirts pullover. Gr 9-12 students may wear their letterman jackets.

\*Apparel may be purchased from Lands' End (with or without the SVA logo) or from a different brand. If the item has the brand logo visible, it must be small and discreet. No other design, stripes or print is allowed.

**Note:** Lands' End pull-over hoodies and quarter-zip fleece pullovers are no longer available **However**, these will be grandfathered in for students who currently own them and will be pulled from circulation as students outgrow them.

*Friday:* Students may wear, SVA sponsored club, HS letterman jackets, extra-curricular, or other school program outerwear.

HATS: Attached hoods, caps, and any other hats are only allowed to be worn outside the building.

#### **BOTTOMS:** Monday - Friday

Grades 5-12<sup>th</sup> students will wear pants, shorts, or skirts in a variety of solid colors.

- Pants or skirts should be plain. No stripes, prints, embroidery, or added decorations are allowed.
- Pants must have a zipper and/or button. All bottoms must adhere to \*modesty guidelines listed below.

**\*5-12 Modesty Guidelines**: Refrain from spandex, skintight pants or shorts, leggings, jeggings, ripped/holes/frayed, shorter than mid-thigh, sagging/bagging, or sweatpants/joggers/athletic wear.

Gr E5/K – Gr 4\_students may only wear solid-colored bottoms (no prints or stripes). Elastic waistbands are permissible.

**\*E5/ K Modesty/ safety guidelines:** Shorts should be worn under skirts, ripped/holes/frayed, closed toe shoes should be worn to protect feet on the playground and in gym class.

<u>JEWELRY:</u> \* is not worn at school, or while participating in any school function, on or off campus. \*Jewelry – earrings, nose rings, bracelets/ wristbands, necklaces, rings, chokers, etc.

HAIRSTYLES: No outlandish hairstyles permitted. Only natural color (for your age) hair dye

NOTE: Students out of dress code will be levied a \$25 fine.
